The Okefenokee RESA Board of Control requires that a current inventory of all properties and equipment be on file in the Okefenokee RESA office. The computerized inventory shall consist of federal, state, and local equipment; and the information maintained shall comply with federal and state requirements. Individual federal programs shall be responsible for maintaining their own inventories. The inventory shall be subject to the capitalization limit set forth in DIB unless otherwise denoted by law. A supplemental manual inventory may be maintained for items under the capitalization level.
