All school sponsored fund raising activities shall be approved by the Executive Director or a designee. Such activities must not be organized, publicized or conducted until approval has been granted. The Executive Director shall develop rules and regulations for fund-raising activities by students. These rules and regulations shall be approved by the Board of Control and placed in the policy manual.

Without prior approval of the Executive Director, students and/or their parents and will be prohibited from selling tickets or merchandise and from engaging in any other commercial activity in the name of the school.

The activities cited below are approved and permission need not be requested in writing, although their scheduling should be cleared through the principal. The Board of Control assumes, however, that the following activities will conform to the rules and regulations set forth by the Executive Director and will be held or carried out under the supervision of the principal and teachers. These activities are as follows

- 1. taking and selling of school pictures
- 2. selling of advertising or subscriptions to official school publications
- 3. concession sales
