

**BOARD POLICY
DISPOSAL PROCEDURES**

CODE: DO

The Okefenokee RESA Board of Control has the power to sell or dispose of unserviceable or surplus property. This sale of the real property shall be at public outcry after advertisement. Before any sale is made, the Okefenokee RESA Board of Control shall adopt a resolution declaring that the property is no longer necessary or convenient for agency, system/school purposes and specifying the terms and manner of the sale. The Okefenokee RESA Board of Control shall reserve the right to reject all bids and shall authorize the Okefenokee RESA Executive Director or designee to conduct the sale, or consign the property for sale.

In event no bid is received on an item at the public sale, the Okefenokee RESA Executive Director and appropriate staff shall be authorized to dispose of the item in a manner most beneficial to the agency, system/school.
