

Transportation of students to the Harrell Learning Center is the sole responsibility of the participating school system. Since each system is responsible for the transportation of the students to the Harrell Learning Center, ensuring that bus drivers meet all state and local requirements and training is the responsibility of each school system. The Harrell Learning Center staff will work with bus drivers, system transportation directors, and school and district administrators to provide a safe, orderly transportation environment.
