

The minimum workday for all professional, certified personnel shall be defined as eight (8) hours, and the minimum work week shall be defined as forty (40) hours. The minimum workday shall entail the duties for which the base salary is paid, such as teaching, consulting, preparation, staff meetings, planning conferences, and related Okefenokee RESA activities.
