

Students receiving services in GNETS classes receive academic instruction based upon the Georgia Performance Standards or Georgia Standards of Excellence. The Board of Control directs and authorizes the Program to expand and enrich the state curriculum to the extent considered necessary and appropriate to meet student needs.

Special Services

The Harrell Learning Center shall operate a minimum of 180 days each fiscal year and may operate up to 200 days. Classes for all students age 3-21 begin at 7:30 and end at 2:30. The school year and school day time requirements remain the same for students in the Harrell Learning Center as for all students in Georgia.
